Wastewater Operation

Supporting the winery with constant monitoring of the various levels influencing the effective running of the plant, including:

- Tank level control
- pH. monitoring and adjustment
- Nutrient monitoring and adjustment
- Winery and waste plant solids removal via Tractor
- Liaise with contractors
- Monitoring the discharge of the system to irrigation fields
- Respond to SMS alarms.

Winemaking Process

Develop and maintain a broad understanding of cellar practices to aid in the better running of the waste plant.

Supporting a successful harvest

When required, provide support to the Cellar and Winemaking teams with daily operations to meet business goals.

Maintenance

Taking initiative to support the wider Winery Engineering team by assisting with Potable Water, Cooling Towers, light engineering practices and other daily maintenance tasks as required.
